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Oak Frame Garden Rooms

A Monarch Oak garden room is an enduring addition to your home. Designed to be used all year round thanks to efficient, high level insulation which keeps it warm in the winter and cool in the summer, it will be a valuable additional living space.

Unlike traditional conservatories an oak frame garden room will incorporate cavity wall brick work, an insulated roof and double glazed hard wood joinery to ensure the building maintains the perfect temperature. Will I need planning?

If you are unsure whether your project will require planning permission visit planningportal.gov.uk and follow the instructions. Alternatively you can contact our in-house sales team who have years of planning experience.

Will I need building control?

All non-agricultural buildings over 30m² or within 1 metre of a boundary will require full building control. We will be happy to help you with this process.
